Building a Safe Haven for Afghan Boys

Your support enabled Hagar to make a bold and vital shift in Afghanistan this year: moving from a residential care model to a community-based approach.

In May, Hagar's frontline team in Kabul opened a Community Protection Centre, which provides holistic wraparound care for hundreds of boys who have escaped exploitation and abuse.

The boys live at home with their families while accessing Hagar's medical care, legal support, trauma counselling, education, and economic empowerment services through the Centre. Each boy has the chance to heal from trauma, and learn vocational skills

like baking and tailoring (pictured below) to forge independent futures.

Afghanistan is one of the harshest places on earth to grow up. Many boys face hunger, violence, and the constant risk of being trafficked.

Amid these challenges, your generosity enabled a strategic shift that will have a lasting difference.

By bringing trauma care, education, and protection directly into communities, you are helping boys *and their families* heal from abuse, rebuild hope, and protect future generations.

As a husband and father of three, Hùng* carried the same dream many parents share: to give his children a better future.

When an employment broker offered a job overseas, it seemed like the answer to his prayers. Hung borrowed tens of thousands of dollars to pay the brokerage fees and signed the contract.

But what followed was a nightmare.

Hùng was trafficked to Russia and then through six countries in Europe. With his passport stolen, he faced beatings, was locked inside shipping containers, and was forced to work on a cannabis farm in the UK. Isolated from the outside world, he had no way of escape.

Months later when police finally raided the house, he was misidentified as a criminal and spent six months in detention before being recognized as a victim of human trafficking.

With your support, this wasn't the end of his story.

Through a partner organization in the UK, Hùng was repatriated to Vietnam where he was welcomed by Hagar.

Because of your generosity, Hùng received the care he needed to reclaim his life and find a brave voice to speak out against exploitation.

Today, Hùng works hard to support his family in their hometown. He also raises awareness about the false claims and job offers traffickers use to lure people in.

"I tell others one thing," he says. "Going abroad is not always better."



When news broke in January of the U.S. Foreign Funding Freeze, it was more than a headline. For 33 child survivors in Hagar's care, it threatened their safety, recovery, and freedom.

These boys and girls, all survivors of trafficking and abuse, were living in family-based survivor care placements across Cambodia, all funded through a US government grant. Each child had a safe home, a trained caregiver, access to education, and counselling to help them heal from trauma.

But when U.S. Foreign Aid froze, without urgent intervention, the children's care was at risk.

Because you stepped in when it mattered most and generously filled the funding gap, all 33 children remained safe in Hagar's care. Every single child remained in their Hagarsupported placement, providing the stability and consistency needed to heal.

No child survivor had to pause their healing journey.

Right now thanks to your support, these child survivors are still receiving:

- Safe, nurturing care from trained foster families
- Trauma counselling and emotional support
- Access to school, play, and life skills training
- The stability every child needs to grow and thrive

Crises don't wait for the perfect moment to arrive. But when a caring community stands ready to act, children can be protected, no matter what happens in the world.
